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



#### Additional: Pharmacist's role in Clinic

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- 1. QC of Clinic Study product accountability processes
- QC of Ring Accountability Records
- QC of Ring Accountability Cover page
- QC of Ring Collection/Insertion (RCI-1)CRF
- 2. QC of Ppt Registration Log (to prevent Co-enrolment)



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- 3. QC of Screening Files
- 4. Review of IC's

(3 and 4 above ,done daily or weekly depending on clinic requirements. Documented on a Pharmacy QC log. Training on clinic file review will be provided by site management)

- Requires attention to detail and effective QA/QC to ensure high quality of work
