So you just completed a visit, and you are ready to fax in those forms...

You fax the forms...

How do you know if SCHARP actually received them??

You can use SCHARP's CRF Tracking System 2!



What is the CRF Tracking System 2 (CTS2)?

 A tool used by the site to confirm the receipt of faxed Case Report Forms (CRFs) at SCHARP.

 This is an optional tool for sites, but is highly recommended



How CTS2 Works

 DataFax CRFs are faxed to SCHARP in batches (groups) of multiple pages.

 Sites are notified that a fax was received via the Fax-reception Report

 Sites are notified which CRFs were received and validated via the CRF-validation report

- displays CRFs validated during specified dates
- generated at the frequency of your choosing (nightly, weekly, etc.) and sent by e-mail



How to Use CTS2

- After receiving the Fax-reception Report, compare the number of pages received at SCHARP to the number faxed in the batch
- If the number of pages received does not match the number of pages faxed, possible causes are:
 - the number of pages in the batch were miscounted
 - two or more pages in a batch stuck together during faxing
- When the numbers don't match, wait for the CRF-validation Report for information about which CRF page(s) were received. Refax those CRF pages not listed.

CTS2 Problem Solving

- Contact SCHARP support
 (<u>support@scharp.org</u>) if you do not receive the
 Fax-reception Report the day after you fax
- Information about individual CRF pages received will be included in the second report, the CRF-validation Report.
 - Report is typically sent 1-3 days after the fax is sent (to allow time for data entry at SCHARP), but in rare occurrences may take up to 10 days.
- If the CRF-validation Report identifies that one or more CRF pages were not received, either refax the form page(s) or contact SCHARP support (support@scharp.org) Statistical Center for Prevention

How Do I Sign Up to Use the CTS2?

- Site completes a sign-up sheet, designating recipients of reports and report frequency.
 - fax from each machine you will use
 - no limit to number of site staff who can receive the e-mail reports
