# LDMS Reconciliation Review

---

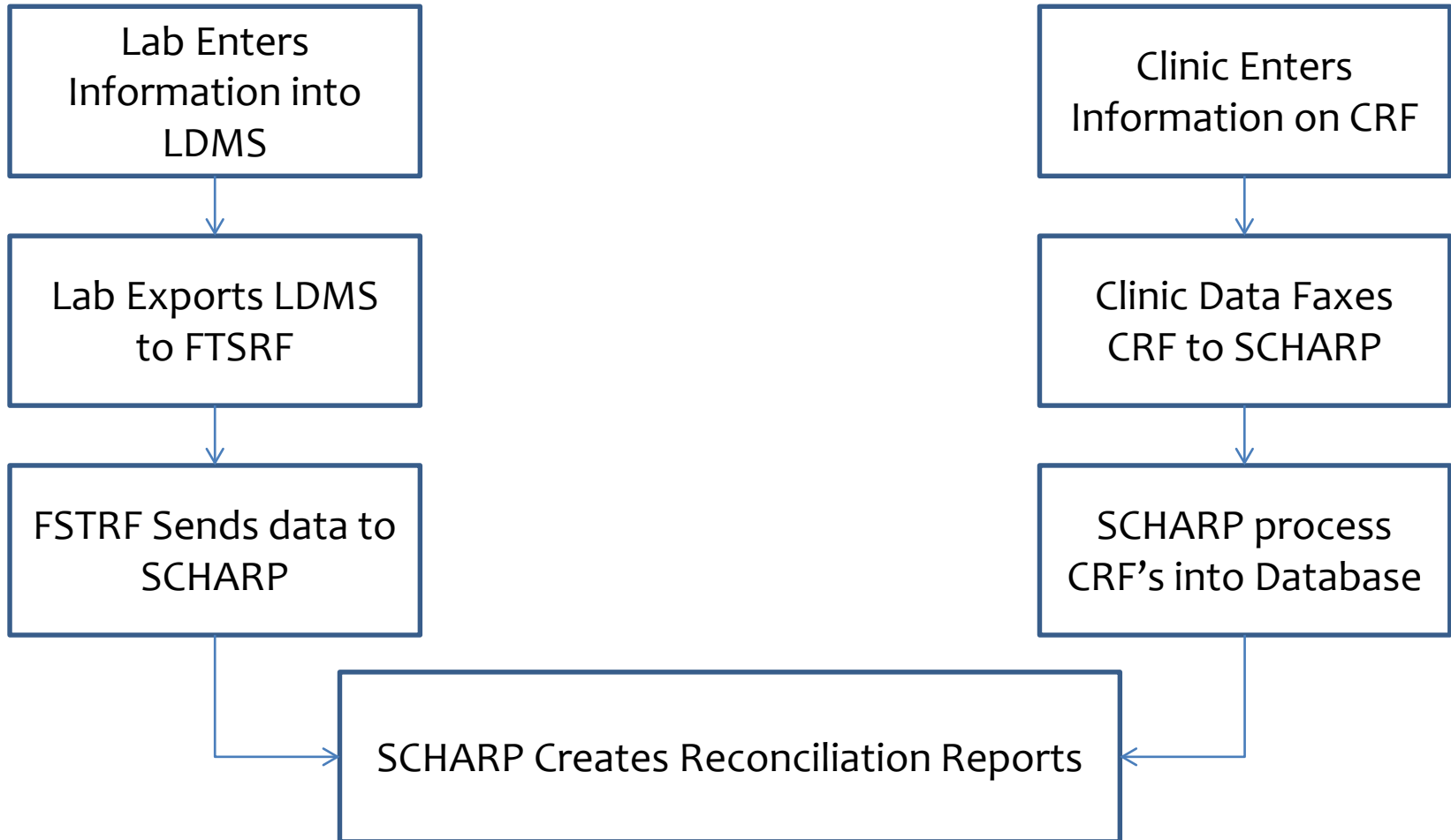
- LDMS Reconciliations are one of our most important QA/QC processes
- Ensure SCHARP has an accurate picture of available samples
- Ensure that samples are stored with correct information
- Pick up problems early in studies to correct processes

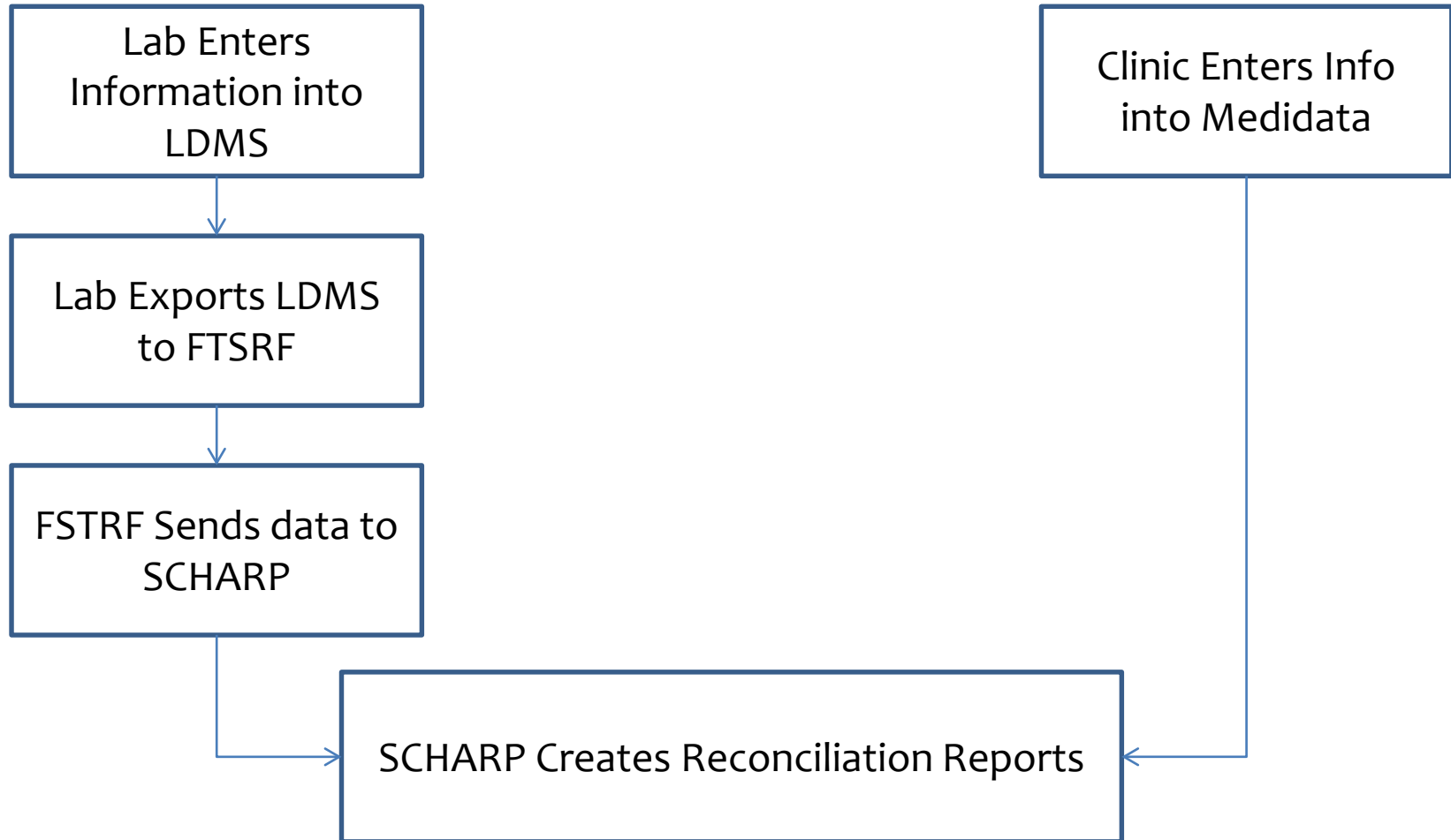

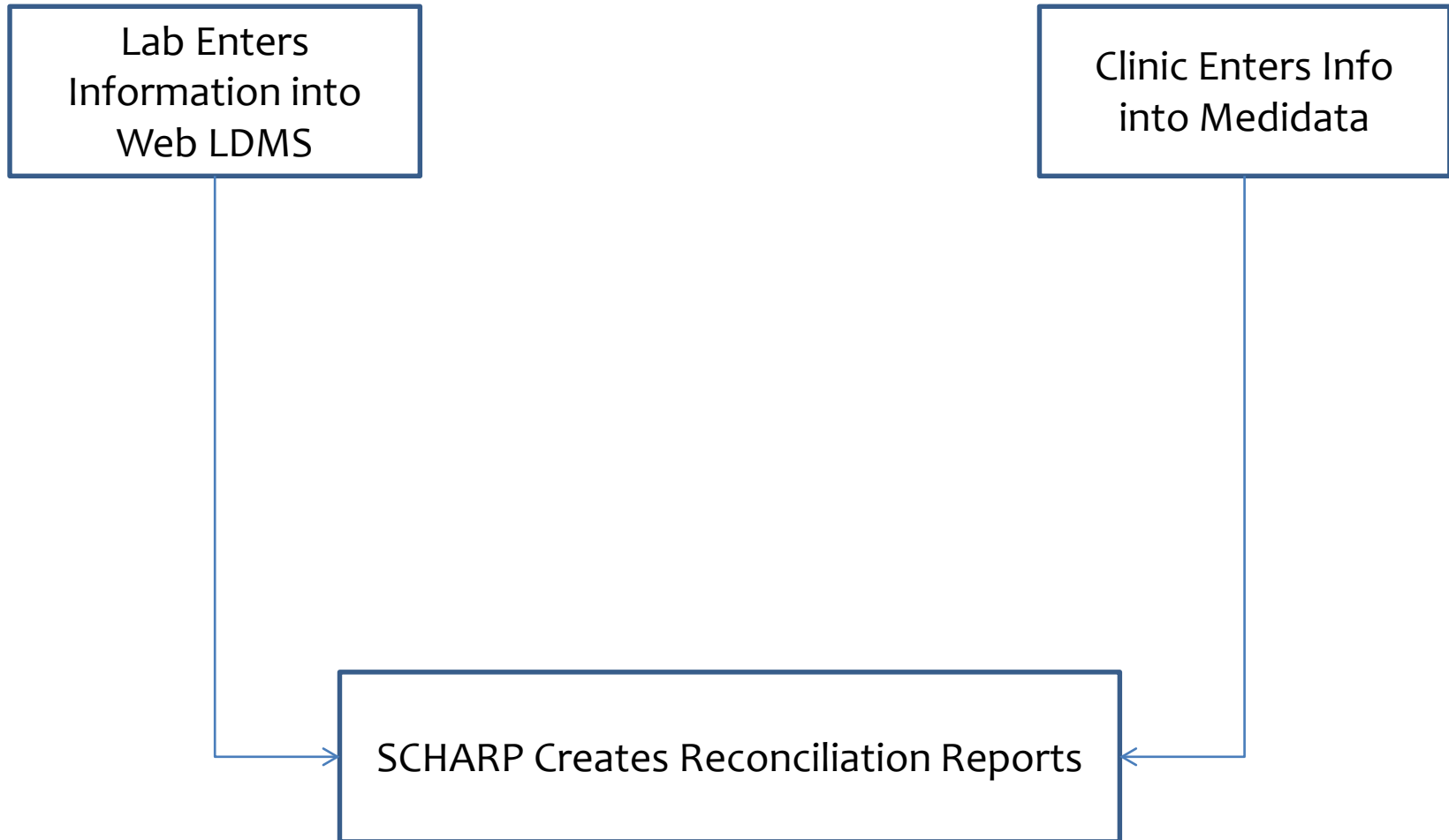
# Old/MTN-015 Reconciliation Process

# Make sure you understand the report format

- LDMS only
- CRF only
- *Same sample on LDMS and CRF only?*
- Partial
- Errors
- Storage

# Make sure you understand report logic

---

- Only data entered into LDMS or CRF/Rave affects LDMS reconciliations
- Sample requisitions and chain of custody documents are good for internal investigation. They don't help LC or SCHARP troubleshoot

---


- Re-fax CRF's once. Don't re-fax multiple times.

# LDMS Export date is crucial

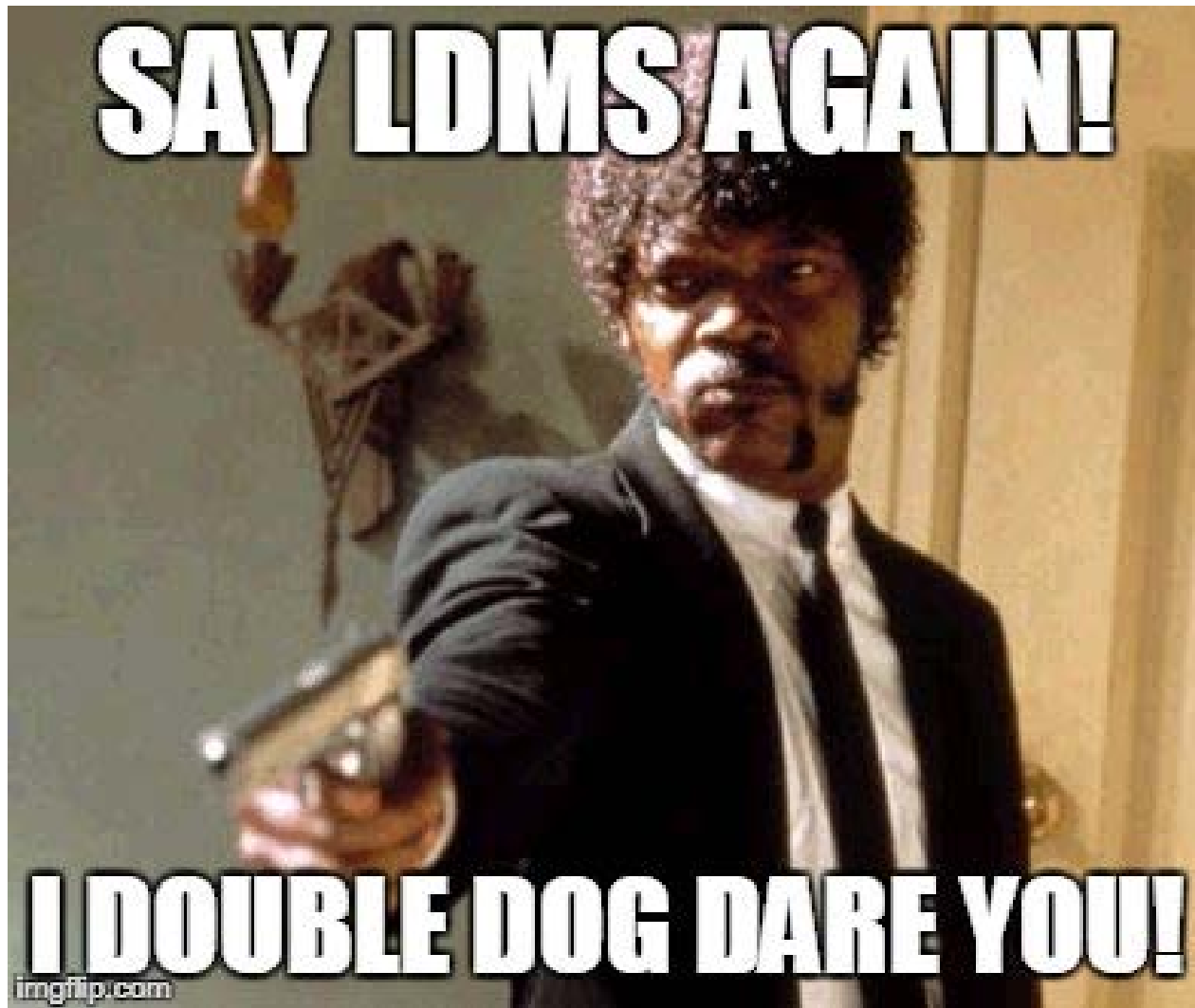

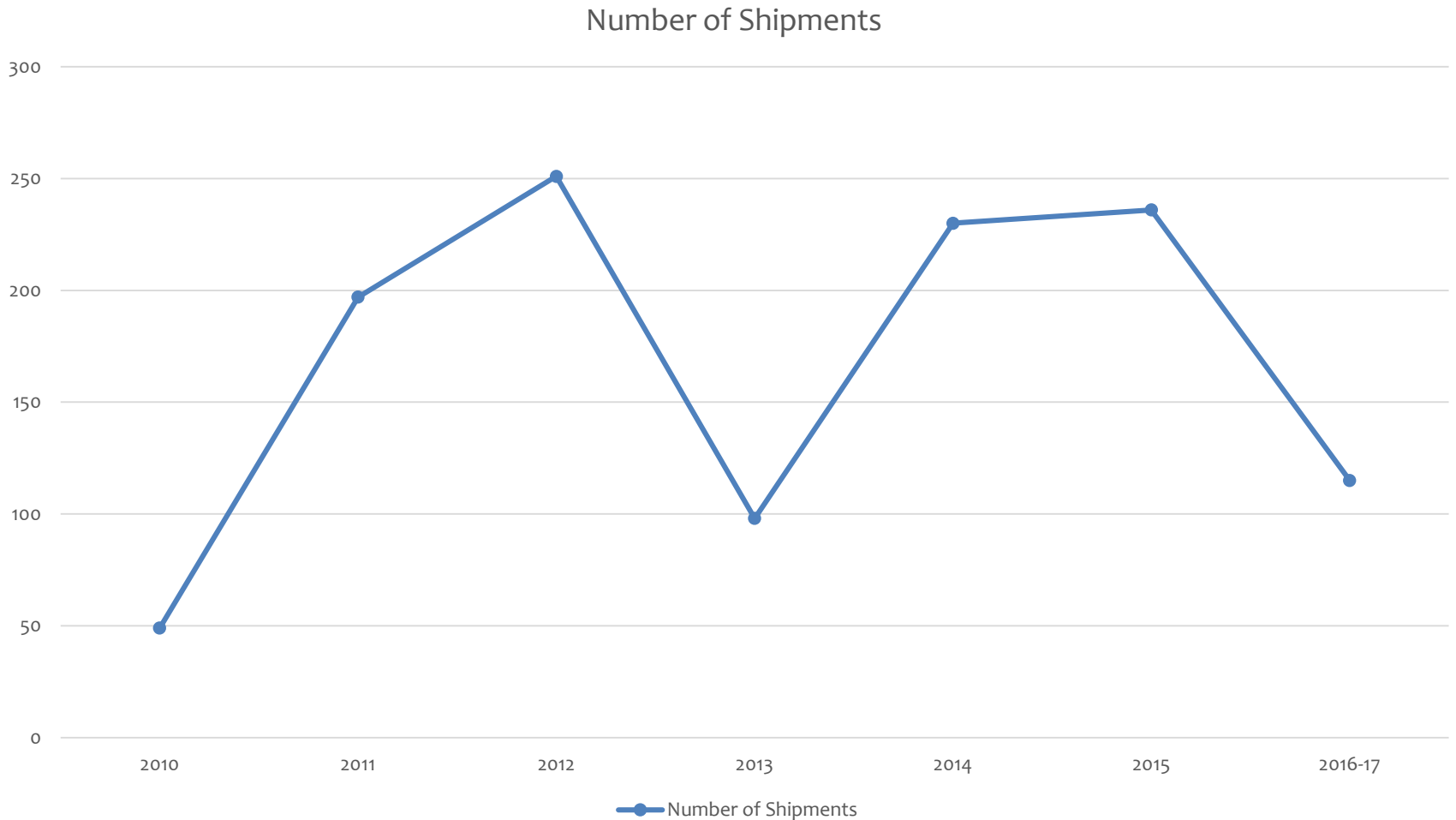


# NEC Shipment tracking: Sites to LC only

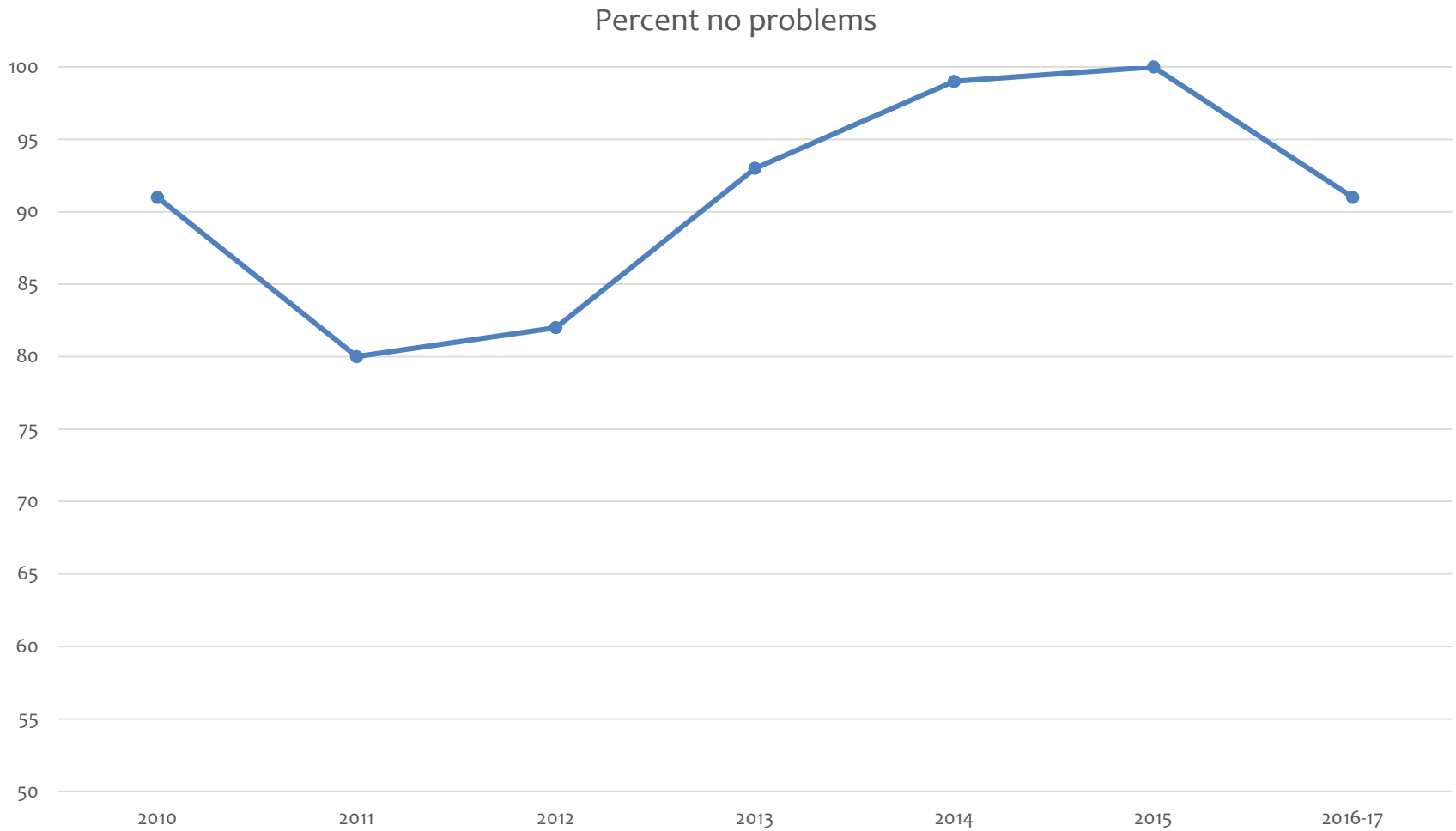
